**BOOKINGS** are only possible via your <u>ParentPay</u> account, please do not email booking requests to the school office.

Clubs will be available to book on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> April from 9.00am.

**CANCELLATIONS** – if your child no longer wishes to attend, please inform us by email to the school office. If your child does not attend for more than two consecutive weeks, without prior notice, then their name will be removed from the register, to enable other children to join.

**OVER SUBSCRIBED CLUBS** – please email the school office if you wish your child's name to be placed on the waiting list.

**CONFIRMATION** - once you have made a booking via ParentPay – please take this as confirmation of your place. It is **NOT** possible to email individually to confirm allocation.

**DATES** - School led clubs will run from week commencing Monday 28<sup>th</sup> April to week ending Friday 18<sup>th</sup> July (11 weeks). The only exception to this is:

Cookery: 2 separate cookery courses, one on Tuesdays for Years 3&4 and one on Wednesdays for Years 5&6, both lasting five-weeks, starting week commencing 28<sup>th</sup> April and continuing after half term until week ending 6<sup>th</sup> June and
