Topography	The arrangement of the natural and artificial physical features of an area.
Landscape	All of the visible features of an area of land.
Regions	An area, especially part of a country, that has definable characteristics but not always fixed boundaries.
Population	All the inhabitants in a particular place.
Mainland	A large continuous extent of land that includes the greater part of a country or territory.
Industries	Economic activity concerned with the processing of raw materials and manufacturing of goods.

The UK is the world's 22nd most-populated country, with some 64 million inhabitants. London, the capital city, covers the third-largest urban area in Europe.

The UK has the sixth-largest national economy in the world.
