St Joseph's Reception Newsletter



The children have had a great week learning and exploring in our environment.

Our new mini topic is 'Moving On' - This Reception-only project celebrates the children's successes throughout their Reception year. It explores how they have grown and changed and supports them with the changes to come as they move into Year 1.

Our key text for next week is: 'Ruby's Worry'. We will be thinking about the children's transition into KS1.

How you can support your child at home:

- Talk to your child about what they are excited about doing in Year 1.
- Ask your child what they know about Year 1 e.g. Where are the children who are in Year 1 going? Do you think they might need a pencil case? Do you think they might may get a morning break on the playground?

Maths- This week children will be focusing on making connections between all aspects of maths that have been covered throughout the year. We will look at deepening this understanding through developing the children's reasoning and problem-solving skills.
