- If you have, inadvertently parked in such a way to cause any obstruction, or part obstruction to a residents' drive, please expect to be asked to move. We are encouraging residents to ask parents and visitors to move if necessary, please be courteous to our neighbours.
- Residents are also being encouraged to inform the school of any cars that repeatedly cause an obstruction, by way of photographic evidence or noting of car number plates. In these cases, the Headteacher will speak directly to the parent.
