



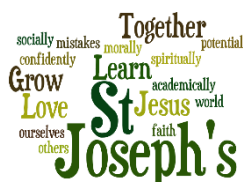

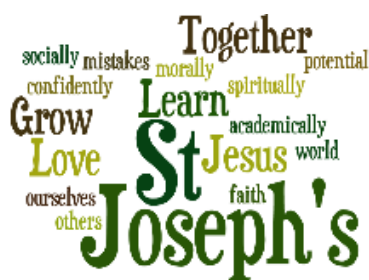

This award recognises a pupil who excels in writing, showing creativity, skill and a genuine passion for the written word.

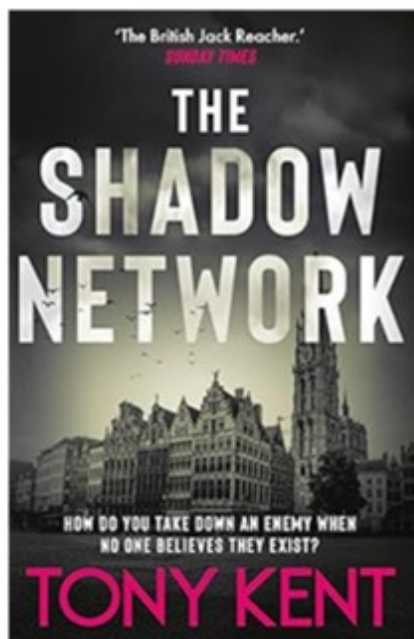

You have had an amazing journey at St Joseph's.

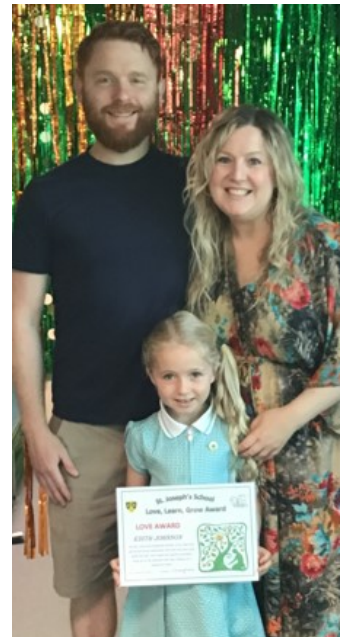
- Despite facing significant academic and social challenges – Dean has shown remarkable courage and resilience as he has gone through school.

Dean you should be very proud of all that you have achieved and the strength of character you demonstrate everyday.

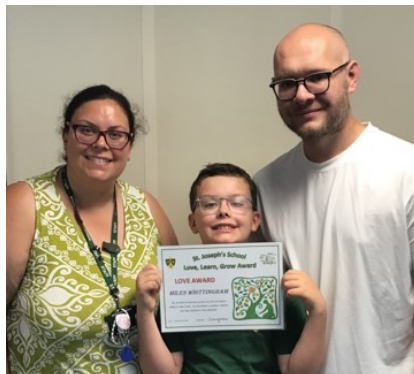

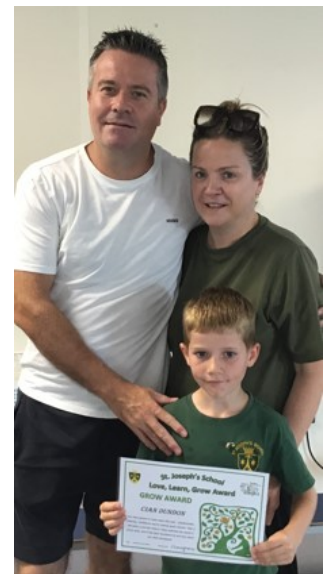
