Topic:

We are starting our mini topic this week, it is called 'Exploring Autumn'. This project teaches children about the natural changes that happen during the season of Autumn, including how the weather changes, why trees lose their leaves and how wild animals prepare for winter. We will be reading 'Pumpkin Soup' by Helen Cooper and exploring lots of different Autumn themes.

We are having some exciting visitors on Wednesday to end our main topic, 'Me and my Community'!

Supporting your child at home

- Go on an Autumn walk with a grown-up and collect some Autumn leaves. Use these leaves to make a picture or collage.
- -Collect some Autumn treasures, such as leaves, sticks, conkers, acorns and pine cones. See what patterns you can make using the treasures. Can you copy a pattern your grown-up has made using the Autumn leaves?

Maths – We will be using our understanding of colours to sort. We will be sorting two colours of an object that are the same size and shape. Then moving to sorting three colours of one objects. Objects may be different sizes such as pom poms or sorting bears.

Supporting your child at home

Sorting activities -

- -Toys- by colour or soft toys and hard toys. Toys by whose they are. All of my toys are here and all of xyz's toys are there.
- -Muffin trays are great for sorting and making groups-children can sort beads by colour/ pompoms etc.
- -Sorting playing cards. All of the red cards here and black cards here. More advanced sort by suit and by number.



We have loved exploring emergency services, we had a lovely visit from Nurse Suzie and Paramedic Bella. The children loved asking questions.


