Topic:

This week we are starting our mini topic 'Winter Wonderland'. This project teaches children about the changes that happen during winter, including the types of weather associated with winter. It also explores places that have snow all year round and the types of animals that live there. Next week we will be reading '*The Gruffalo Child*' by Julia Donaldson. We will be exploring snow and ice and the changes in our weather.

Supporting your child at home

Sensory Snow Play: Mix baking soda and shaving cream (or flour/oil) to create 'snow' for digging, scooping, and building, focusing on cold, soft textures.

Winter Colouring & Art: Use winter colouring pages (penguins, snowflakes) or paint with white/blue/silver to make winter scenes, developing hand-eye coordination.

Hot & Cold Exploration: Touch ice cubes vs. warm water, feel cold window panes, or make hot cocoa (with adult help), discussing temperature.

Maths:

Next week we will continue to order numbers 1,2,3,4,5,6. Our special number will be number will be 5. We will continue to look at the different ways it is represented and composition of 5.




We will also be working on identifying pentagons by counting the sides.

Supporting your child at home

- Ask a grown-up or friend to place between 0 to 5 small objects in a bag. Without looking, feel inside the bag and count how many objects there are. Can you point to this number?
- Ask a grown-up to a tower using between 1 and 5 bricks. Count the number of bricks they used and hold up the matching number.


