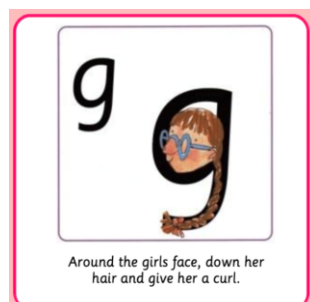
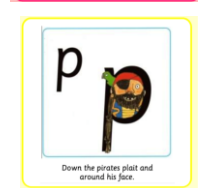
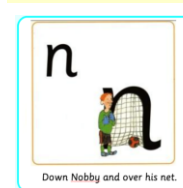
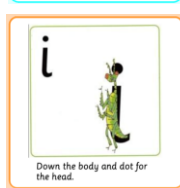
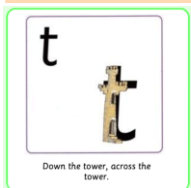
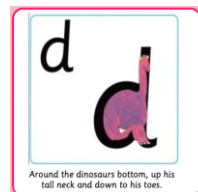


Supporting your child at home

Please explore the different phonics sounds to support your child's learning.



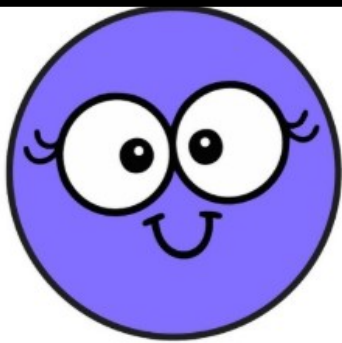


Maths – Next week we will be revisiting shapes. Children will identify circles, triangles, squares and rectangles and begin to learn about their properties.

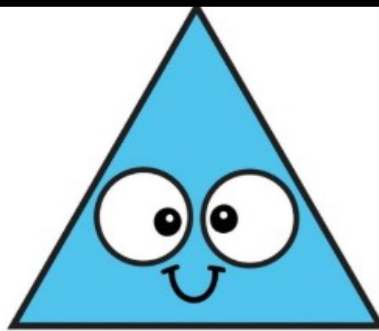
Supporting your child at home-

- How do you know your objects are circles and triangles?

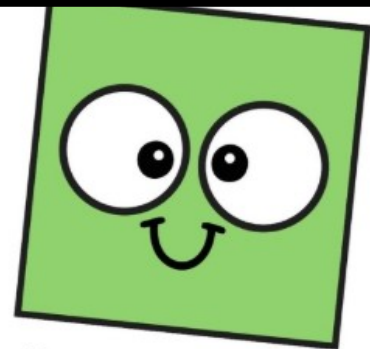
Our Star Poems

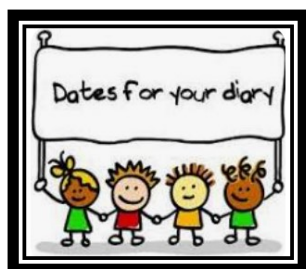

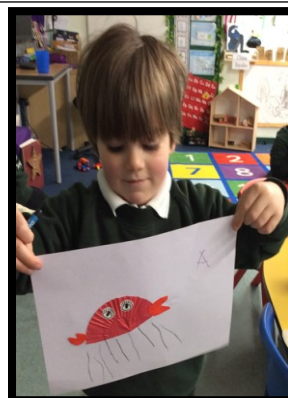

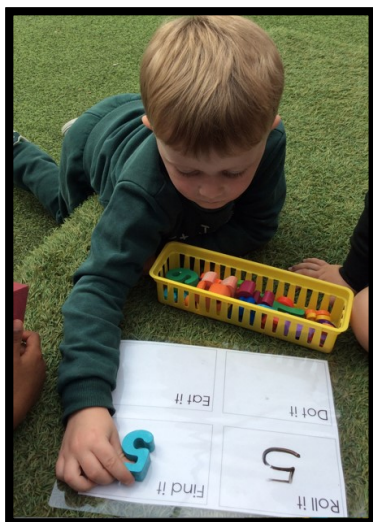
We have enjoyed planting more seedlings, watering them and watching our plants grow!
