How you can support your child at home:

Ask your child what they know about Year 1 e.g. Where are the children who are in Year 1 going? Do they think they might need a pencil case? Do they think they may get a morning break on the playground?

Maths- This week children will be looking at all of topics we have learnt during Reception and pick from a range of activities to further their understanding.


