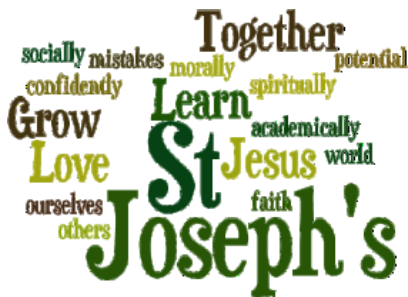

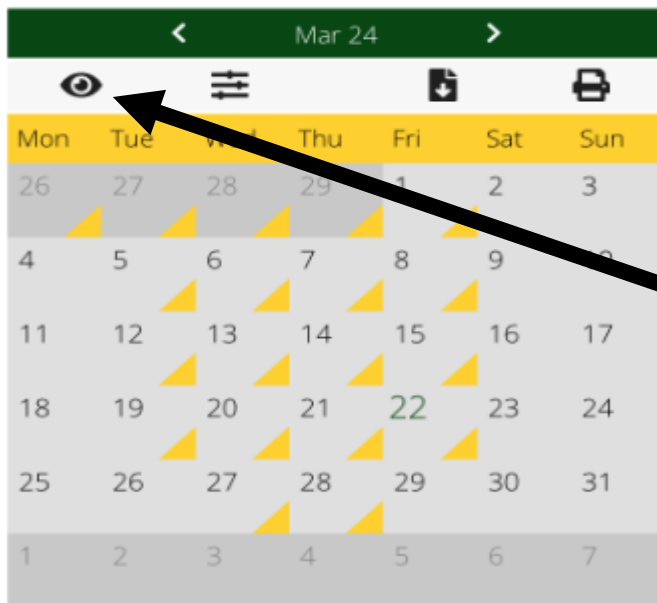

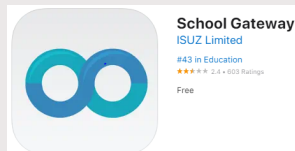


Following feedback regarding the calendar view on the School App, we have adjusted the capability to view events.
