



Want to wait to give your child a smartphone but don't want them to be the odd one out?

*You're not alone! There's a growing movement of parents in Buckinghamshire (and across Britain) who are choosing to wait to give their children smartphones. The Parent Pact is a way to join together with other families at St. Joseph's to agree to delay getting your child a smartphone until at least 14.

SECONDARY SCHOOL FORMS

If you need your child's secondary school application form signed or require a Certificate of Catholic Practice, Fr Bob will be available on Monday 13 October at 6pm,

NB: Fr Bob will not be available outside of these dates to do this as he is away and won't return until November.

COPIES OF BAPTISM CERTIFICATES

Requests should be made by contacting the Parish Office.

Parents should include details of the child for whom the certificate is required, their date of birth, date of baptism and names of their parents and godparents when asking for a Baptism Certificate.

Please allow a minimum of five working days to turn around requests.

SAFEGUARDING AT THE END OF THE DAY

A reminder that you can enter school via the KS1 playground and the KS2 side gate in the afternoon. If you are only collecting from KS2 (Years 3-6) please use the side gate.

Please do not go around to the KS2 playground (if you have entered via KS1) until 3.30pm. We need to safely move all of the children to the KS2 playground to be picked up and this becomes complicated for the teachers and children if there are adults in the middle of this process.

We kindly ask that you leave the school, if you are on the KS2 playground, by the KS2 gate side gate —please do not come back via the marquees onto the KS1 playground.

A gentle reminder also, that there is no parking on the school site to collect children from clubs (exception of Busy Living). This has been in the newsletter for several weeks and there are still parents (particularly on Friday evenings) trying to drive onto the site.
