

Read Write Inc

Next week the children in Years 1-2 will be resorted into their groups for the next couple of weeks. As you are aware children are re-assessed every 6 weeks and groups are adjusted. Some children will remain in the same group to consolidate aspects of their phonics and read learning and some children will move groups. It is not the case that children should move groups every 6 weeks and go up a colour. Please do not be anxious if your child has not moved groups—if we are concerned we will speak to you about their progress.

Reception will continue with whole class sessions and targeted progress groups.

Some of the children will now bring home daily Ditty Sheets (in plastic wallets) - please read the letter that will come home on Monday that explains the 'Ditty Group'. The rest of the children will continue with the Making a Strong Start Programme—recapping set 1 sounds, focussing on blending to make words and letter formation.







