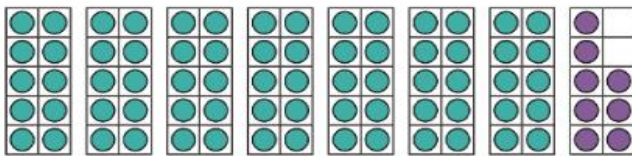

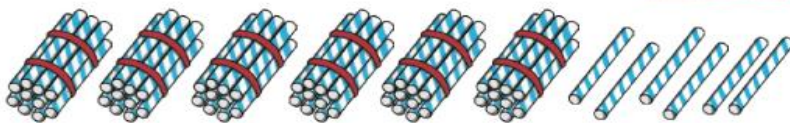
Vocabulary	
<u>Sort</u>	Put into groups
<u>Count</u>	To say numbers in order or to work out how many
<u>Total</u>	To say how many
<u>More</u>	A larger amount
<u>Less</u>	A smaller amount
<u>Fewer</u>	Not many
<u>Equal to</u>	The same as something else
<u>Greater than</u>	When one number or group is bigger than another
<u>Less than</u>	When one number or group is smaller than another
<u>Compare</u>	The ways things are the same or different
<u>Number</u>	A sign used for counting
<u>First</u>	Before something else
<u>Second</u>	Next or after the first
<u>Third</u>	After the second
<u>Last</u>	Come at the end
<u>Smallest</u>	Little or tiny

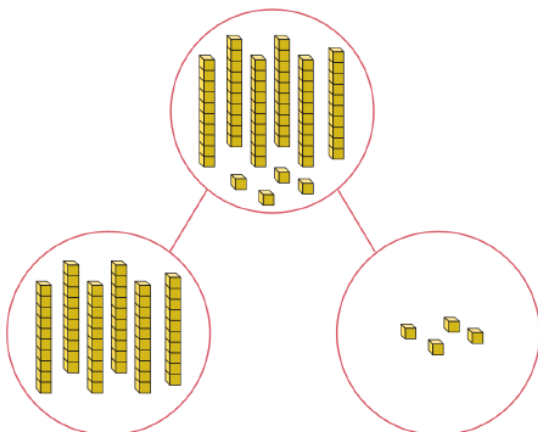
