That's the rule. That's the deal.

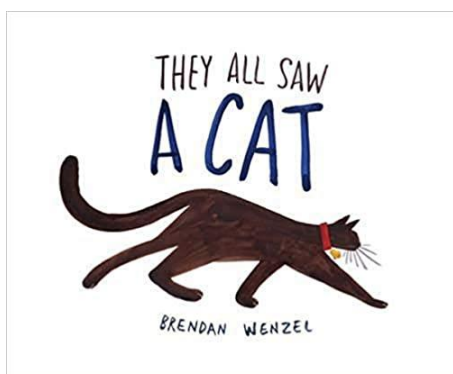
Probably not the best one to read at bed time though, you'll never get to sleep after all the laughing!
