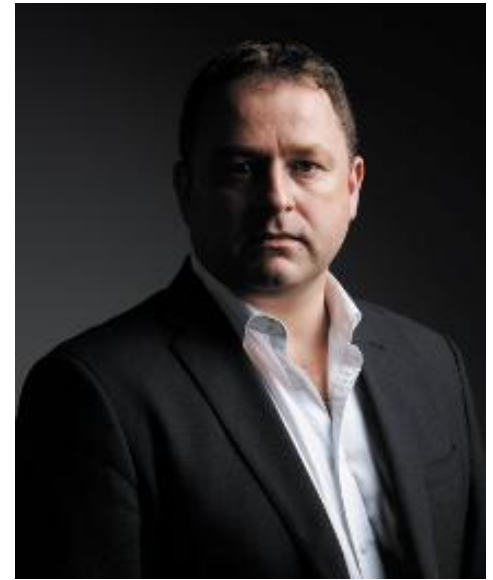
Tony Kent Writer Award

This award recognises a pupil who excels in writing, showing creativity, skill and a genuine passion for the written word.

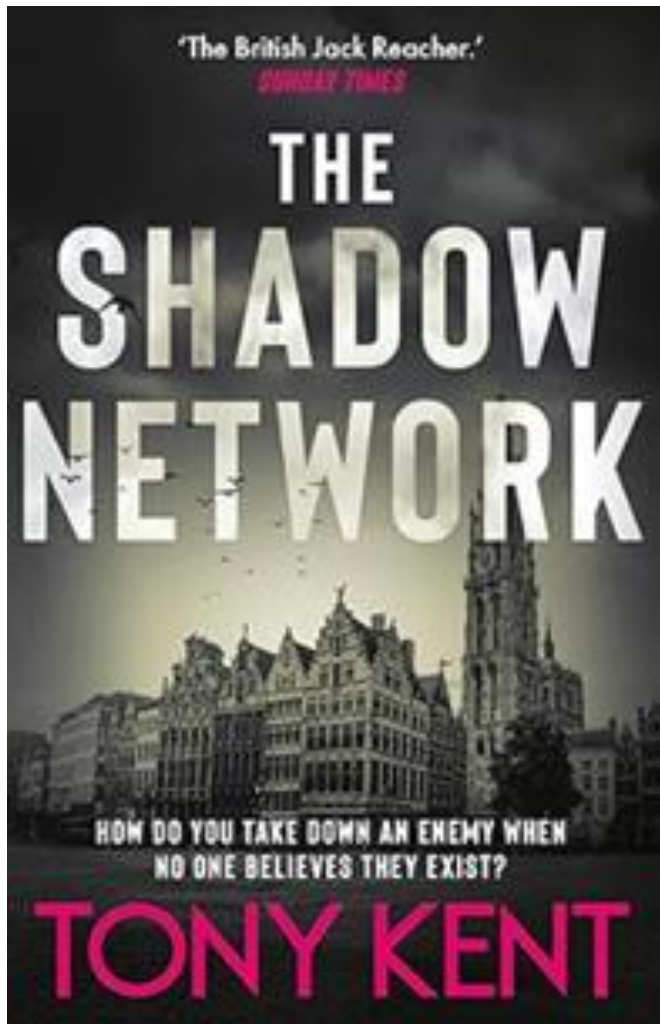

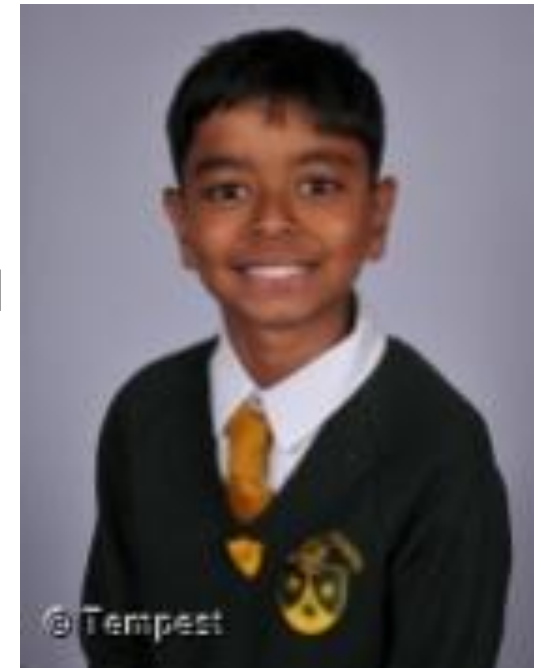
Citizenship Award
